

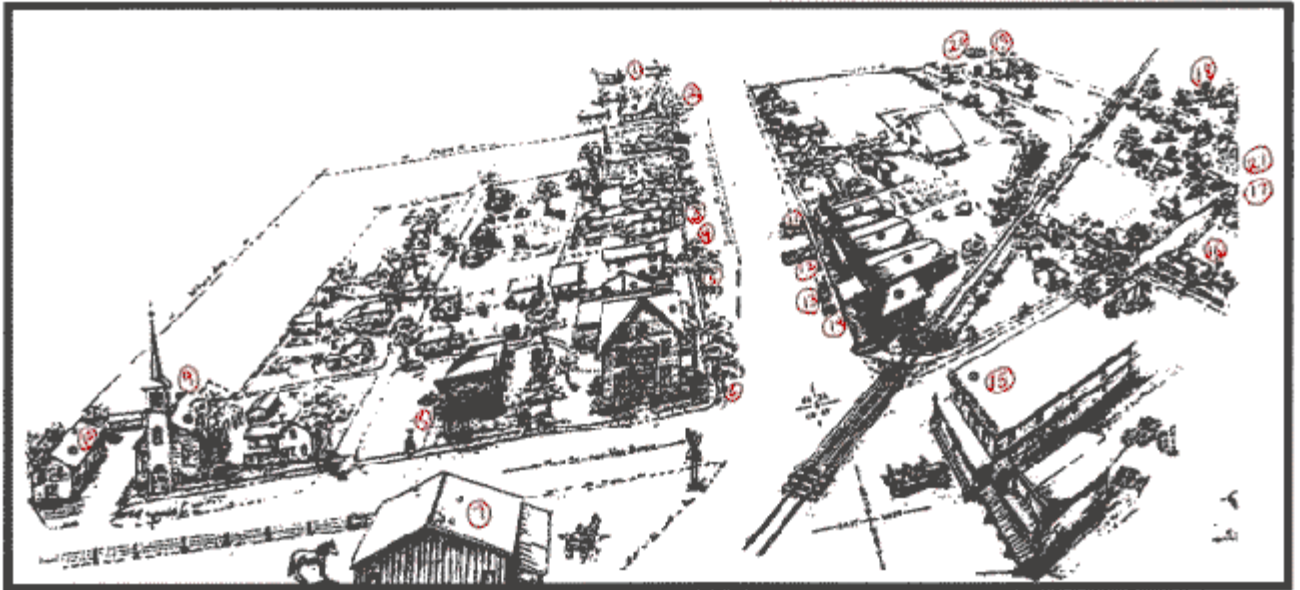
Robbery, Arson & Murder

This 200 page spiral bound book, compiled by Evelyn Sawyer and Shirley Krombeen features over 400 black and white photographs from the early nineteenth hundreds through the 1950's.

It covers not only the City of Hudsonville, but also the surrounding areas including Georgetown, Jamestown and Blendon townships. Mrs. Sawyer, a long-time resident and member of the West Michigan Genealogical Society has written text to explain the photographs and maps.
